1. Entry Requirements

- ① aged between 18 to 55
- ② in good health.

2. Application period: Mar. 1 to May 15, 2025

4. Study period: June 30 to July 25, 2025

Class Time: Monday to Friday, 8:20 - 11:40

5. Application fee: RMB¥450 (Nonrefundable)

Tuition RMB¥5000 (Including optional course fee, each person can only choose one optional course; Textbook fees excluded)

- **6.** Courses (A minimum number of 12 students is required to start a class)
- (1) **Main courses:** (20 students per class on average with a placement test on the registration day)
 - ➤ Intensive Chinese (4 levels: A to D) \rightarrow Appendix (4)
 - \triangleright Business Chinese \rightarrow Appendix (4);
- (2) **Optional courses:**(A minimum number of 10 students is required to start a class, the specific subjects and the class time are subject to the actual arrangement of the university)
 - > Once a week (Tue. or Thur.) (90 minutes each time)

Chinese calligraphy (control in 25 students per class)

Tai Chi (control in 15 students per class)

> Twice a week (Mon. & Wed.) (90 minutes each time)

Chinese Character (control in 30 students per class)

*Materials need to be purchased by oneself

7. Procedure of and notes for application

- 1) Apply online at http://applychinese.sjtu.edu.cn. Register with your email address, sign in with your email address and initial password, choose "Summer Program", fill out all the required information.
- 2) Upload Documents:
 - 1. A photocopy of your passport page with personal information and photo. If you are already in China, please provide a photocopy of your valid Visa or Residence Permit as well. (jpg, ≤3MB)
 - 2. A photocopy of your recent photo (jpg, 2.2x2.8cm, 300 pixels/inch, ≤10k, Bareheaded).
- 3) The application fee could be paid online, or bank transfer or pay by credit/banking card in our office. Please DON'T transfer through ATM.

8. About Admission

- * Students must study on **student visa or Residence Permit**. Those who have no valid visa will not be allowed to enroll at SJTU. According to the latest regulations of China's Ministry of Education, if you are admitted to the university, we will issue **the electronic version of the Admission Notice and the electronic version of the Visa Application Form(DQ form)**. The electronic version of "Visa Application Form" needs to be downloaded by the applicant, and the electronic version of "Admission Notice" will be sent by email. Applicant can bring these documents with a valid ordinary passport to the Chinese Embassy or Consulate to apply for **a student visa**. Those who are already in China need to submit a copy of the visa page together with the other application documents.
- 2) All applicants should register at school on time. Absence on the registration day (excluding with the permission of the university) will be regarded as withdraw from this program.

3) The application documents will not be returned and the application fee is non-refundable. The tuition should be paid before or on registration day and it is non-refundable. If the student is not admitted due to unsuccessful document review, no refund of application fee will be made.

Appendix (4)

Introduction of Intensive Chinese

This course is intended to train the communication skills of foreign students by focusing on topics closely related to their life, study and work in China. Students learn vocabulary, grammar rules, expressions and culture related topics which are useful in communication to improve their listening and speaking abilities.

This course is scheduled for four or six weeks with 4 class hours (1class hour = 45 minutes) every day. There are 4 levels and placement test will be given on the registration day.

Elementary: Target students: students with no experience in learning Chinese

Contents:phonetic training, most commonly-used vocabulary and sentence patterns, and basic communication skills in daily life.

Textbook: Quick Success in Oral Chinese: Introduction (Vol. 1)

Basic: Target students: beginners mastering about Chinese 800 words

Contents: commonly-used vocabulary, special sentence patterns, compounds entences and communication skills in daily life and on other social occasions.

Textbook: Quick Success in Oral Chinese: Basic

Intermediate: Target students: intermediate level, mastering about Chinese 1500 words

Contents: frequently-used vocabulary, essential Chinese grammar and communication skills in daily life and on other social occasions.

Textbook: Quick Success in Oral Chinese: Enhancement

Advanced: Target students: intermediate level, mastering 2,000 to 2,500 Chinese words.

Contents: essential Chinese grammar and vocabulary, special sentence patterns and communication skills on more complicated social occasions.

Textbook: Quick Success in Oral Chinese for Intermediate

Business Chinese (Intermediate) - Introduction

1) Objective and prerequisites

It is suitable for learners who have already had about 1000 hours of Chinese learning experience and are interested in business Chinese, and requires learners to have preliminary listening, speaking, reading and writing skills and the ability to use Chinese for daily communication.

2) Learning goals and teaching methods





Appendix (5): How to get the DQ Visa Application form

According to the Chinese Ministry of Education, the paper version of the JW202/DQ visa application form will not be issued, and students are required to download this paper by themselves. Students need to visit the "study in China" official web (https://www.studyinchina.edu.cn), click "Visa Application", and input the required information to download the JW202/DQ form. Students study in China for more than 180 days will get the JW202 form, and students study in China for less than 180 days will get the DQ form.






1) Passport name, passport number and email address must be consistent with the application form. Enter the verification code and click to get the random code. The random code will be sent to the email, and you need to fill it in time after receiving it. The validity period of the verification code and random code is 10 minutes. Please click again after the expiration.



2) After the information is completed, click the query to jump to the certificate download page, click the download button to complete the download. Please download in PDF format, send to your email and save. The maximum number of downloads per certificate is 10. Please do not download the license repeatedly. It is recommended to use the PC.



Appendix (6): Q&A

1. How should the application fee and the tuition be paid?

- 1) Registration fee can be paid online or via bank transfer.
- 2) Tuition fee: can be paid in advance or online, or by card POS on the day of registration.

2. Does Shanghai Jiao Tong University provide certificates and transcripts?

Students are required to attend classes every day and take the final exam. Certificates and transcripts will be provided upon the completion of the courses.

3. Are teenagers aged between 16 and 17 years eligible for the program?

No, they cannot. The applicants should be aged between 18-55.

4. Can I enter China with a Tourist Visa, a Family Visitor Visa or a Business Visa, etc.? Can I study in China without a student visa?

No. Those who have no valid student visa (X1/X2) or Residence Permit will be rejected to enroll or study at SJTU. Tourist Visa, Family Visitor Visa and Business Visa cannot be changed into Student Visa in China.
