Shanghai Jiao Tong University Long-term Chinese Language Course (Full time)

[Introduction]

The Chinese language teaching in International Chinese Education Center of School of Humanities at Shanghai Jiao Tong University has a history of nearly 30 years. Currently, Chinese classes include the general track, (which is divided into 6 levels), Program for Chinese Heritage Learners (Huayiban), Advanced Culture and Business Course and other special classes, as well as elective courses such as Chinese Calligraphy, Taichi.

The International Chinese Education Center employs experienced teachers, most of whom have the PHD degree, or possess abundant experience teaching Chinese overseas. The school features small classes and all classrooms are equipped with multi-media teaching facilities. Since 2003, the university has set up HSK test centers, providing comfortable and considerate services for the examinees.

Students have the opportunity to participate in a variety of extracurricular activities, for instance, a foreign student talent competition, dragon boat racing, table tennis competitions and a New Year's Party to further develop their abilities, cultivate their interests and make new friends.

Shanghai Jiao Tong University is located in Xujiahui area, which boasts convenient transportation options and an elegant learning environment.

[Period of Schooling]

Students may apply for either one semester or one academic year of long-term refresher Chinese course. Each semester is 17 weeks long, students may apply for an extension based on their respective circumstances when the period of schooling is due.

Special classes

♦ Program for Chinese Heritage Learners (Huayiban)

• Target students:

The program is for students with Chinese background who can communicate in Chinese (no less than the level of our school after completing Elementary A) in daily life but have very limited ability in reading and writing Chinese characters (knowing less than 200 Chinese characters).

Program Objectives:

Rapidly improve students' ability to read and write Chinese characters through intensive training, and at the same time correspondingly improve their original Mandarin listening and speaking skills, so that most of them can catch up with their listening and speaking skills, and strive to enter the intermediate level after one semester.

Program format: 20 class hours per week

Reading & Writing: 12 class hours/ week Listening & Speaking: 8 class hours / week

♦ Advanced Culture and Business Course

• Target students: advanced students

Program Objectives:

To provide seminars on Chinese traditional culture, Chinese society and Chinese economy for advanced students who want to take deeper dive into China.

• Program format:

20 class hours per week, with the following classes: Advanced Business Chinese, Financial Chinese, Selected Readings of Chinese Literature, Chinese history and culture, English to Chinese Translation, etc. (Classes may vary. Please refer to the class schedule)

Elective courses

HSK Tutoring class, Tai Chi, Chinese Calligraphy

【Cultural Activities & language practice】

- (1) Visits to historic cultural sites and natural sights in and around Shanghai;
- (2) Art viewing;
- (3) Language practice with Chinese cultural or historic sites viewing.

(Fees)

1. Application Fee: RMB 450 – nonrefundable

2. Tuition: RMB 9,900/semester, RMB 19,800/academic year

3. Tuition for elective courses: RMB 200/course, excluding cost of materials

- 4. Payment:
- (1) Application Fee: online payment or bank remittance.
- (2) Tuition: bank remittance before registration day or by bank card/credit card on the registration day. The acceptable bank cards include China UnionPay (not charge fee), VISA and MASTER. The extra charge (1.9%-3.5%)) of international bank cards is to be paid by students themselves.

[Application Requirements]

- 1. A valid passport.
- 2. Aged from 18 to 55 and in good health.
- 3. Abide by the laws of the People's Republic of China and observe the rules and regulations of the university

[Application Procedure]

Step 1: Online application, Register with your email address, sign in with your email address and initial password, complete online application on the web-site of http://applychinese.sjtu.edu.cn

Step 2: Upload Documents:

- 1. A photocopy of your passport page with personal information and photo. If you are already in China, please provide a photocopy of your valid Visa or Residence Permit as well. (jpg, ≤3MB)
- 2. A photocopy of your recent photo (jpg, 2.2x2.8cm, 300 pixels/inch, ≤10k, Bareheaded).
- 3. Supplementary Information Form for Language Students
- 4. If you are studying at another university/school in China, please submit a study transcript and an attendance letter issued by the International Student Office or the school of your host university with their contact information.

Step 3: Pay the application fee RMB 450: It could be online payment paid, wire transfer through the bank or paying in credit/banking card in our office. Please DON'T transfer through ATM. Please refer to Appendix ④ for Remittance Information.

Step 4: Submit the application form

Admission and registration

- 1. We will issue an Admission Notice and Visa Application for Study in China (JW202 form) to those who are accepted by Shanghai Jiao Tong University.
- Students should bring their passport, Admission Notice and Visa Application for Study in China (JW202 form) and other required documents to the Embassy or Consulate of the People's Republic of China to apply for a student Visa (X1 or X2).
- 3. Students shall come to Shanghai Jiao Tong University on the registration date indicated on the Admission Notice.
- 4. Students will get the timetable (Please refer to Appendix ①) after checking passport and visa, buying insurance, paying the tuition, placement test and so on during the registration day.

5. If the student is not admitted due to unsuccessful document review, the application fee will not be refunded.

[Insurance]

According to the pertinent regulations of the Ministry of Education and the school, the school will exercise full-member insurance system for the international students. International students must have the insurance in accordance with relevant national regulations and school requirements. (Visa)

Students must study with student visa. But the student visa doesn't have any working or internship permission. Those who have no valid student visa (X1/X2) or Residence Permit on the passport will be rejected to enroll or study at SJTU. (Accommodation Registration)

No on-campus accommodation for non-degree Chinese Language students

According to Article 39 of the Exit and Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China, foreigners who live or stay in a residence other than a hotel shall register with the public security organ of their place of residence and make a declaration within 24 hours after check-in. The procedure is as follows: Please go to the Student Service Center of Xuhui Campus to obtain the Temporary Accommodation Registration Form with your passport and rental contract; After that, take the FORM to the local police station to apply for the REGISTRATION FORM OF TEMPORARY RESIDENCE for overseas personnel. Overseas residents can also scan the QR code by mobile phone, select a language, and self-declare after registration.



Refund Policy

If you withdraw from the course in the middle of the semester, the registration fee will not be refunded. According to the Chinese Language Handbook for International Students, 75% of the tuition fee will be refunded in the first two weeks of the course, 50% of the tuition fee will be refunded in the third week, and from the fourth week onwards, the tuition fee for the semester will not be refunded.

Certificate of Completion

Students are required to attend class on time and take the final exam every day. Those who pass the examination may obtain a certificate of completion and a transcript.


