Shanghai Jiao Tong University Long-term Chinese Language Course (Full time)

[Introduction]

The Chinese language teaching at the International Chinese Education Center of the School of Humanities at Shanghai Jiao Tong University has a history of nearly 30 years. Currently, Chinese classes include the General track, (which is divided into 9 levels), the Program for Chinese Heritage Learners (Huayiban), the Advanced Culture and Business Course and other special classes, as well as elective courses such as Chinese Calligraphy, Taichi.

The International Chinese Education Center employs over 70 experienced teachers, most of whom have a Ph.D. degree or possess abundant experience teaching Chinese overseas. The Center features small class sizes and all classrooms are equipped with multi-media teaching facilities. Since 2003, the university has set up HSK test centers, providing comfortable and considerate services for the examinees.

Outside of the classroom, students can participate in a variety of extracurricular activities, for instance, foreign student talent competitions, museum and theater visits, intangible cultural heritage experiences, etc. to further develop their abilities, cultivate their interests, and make new friends.

Shanghai Jiao Tong University is located in the Xujiahui area, which boasts convenient transportation options and an elegant learning environment.

[Period of Schooling]

Students may apply for either one semester or one academic year. Each semester is 17 weeks long and students may apply for an extension based on their respective circumstances at the end of the semester.

(Type of long-term Chinese language classes **)**

• General track:

- 1. The general track has a total of 20 class hours per week. Please refer to <u>Appendix (1)</u> for a sample class schedule.
- 2. Levels: The track is divided into 9 levels: Elementary 1, Elementary 2, Elementary 3, Elementary 4, Intermediate 1, Intermediate 2, Intermediate 3, Advanced 1 and Advanced 2.

♦ Program for Chinese Heritage Learners (Huayiban)

• Target students:

The program is for students with a Chinese background (belonging to the Chinese diaspora) who can communicate in Chinese (no less than the level of our school after completing Elementary A) in daily life but have very limited ability in reading and writing Chinese characters (knowing less than 200 Chinese characters).

• Program Objectives:

Rapidly and simulatenously improve students' ability to read and write Chinese characters as well as their original Mandarin listening and speaking skills through intensive training. Most students should feel confident enough to enter the intermediate level after one semester.

Program format: 20 class hours per week

Reading & Writing: 12 class hours/ week Listening & Speaking: 8 class hours / week

♦ Advanced Culture and Business Course (Advanced 3)

• Target students: advanced students

• Program Objectives:

To provide seminars on Chinese traditional culture, Chinese society, and Chinese economy for advanced students who want to take a deeper dive into China.

• Program format :

20 class hours per week, with the following classes: Advanced Business Chinese, Financial Chinese, Selected Readings of Chinese Literature, Chinese History and Culture, English to Chinese Translation, etc. (Classes may vary. Please refer to the class schedule)

[Elective courses]

HSK Tutoring class, Tai Chi, Chinese Calligraphy

[Cultural Activities & language practice]

Visits to historic cultural sites and natural sights in Shanghai;

[Semesters & Registration periods]

Spring semester: February to June. **Application Period:** September 15th to December 15th of last year

Fall semester: September to January **Application Period:** March 15th to June 15th

Study period: 2025 Fall semester: Sep.15 2025 to Jan.16 2026 2026 Spring semester: March 2 2025 to July 3 2026

[Fees]

- 1. Application Fee: RMB 450 nonrefundable
- 2. Tuition: RMB 10,500/semester, RMB 21,000/academic year (Includes 1 elective courses and cultural experience activities, does not include optional course materials and travel)
- 3. Textbook: around 300RMB
- 4. Payment:
- (1) Application Fee: online payment or bank remittance.

(2) Tuition: bank remittance before registration day or by bank card/credit card on the registration day. The acceptable bank cards include China UnionPay (not charge fee), VISA and MASTER. The extra charge (1.9%-3.5%)) of international bank cards is to be paid by students themselves.

(Application Requirements **)**

- 1. A valid passport (passport should have a validity period of at least one year)
- 2. Aged from 18 to 60 and in good health.
- 3. Abide by the laws of the People's Republic of China and observe the rules and regulations of the university

[Application Procedure]

Step 1: Online application

Register with your email address, sign in with your email address and initial password, complete the online application at <u>http://applychinese.sjtu.edu.cn.</u> You are required to provide 2 email addresses to avoid a failure to receive the admission documents.

Step 2: Upload Documents:

- 1. A photocopy of your passport page with personal information and photo. If you are already in China, please provide a photocopy of your valid Visa or Residence Permit as well. (jpg, \leq 3MB)
- 2. A recent photo (Color photo in jpg/jpeg format, pixel bigger than 295x413, ≤200kb).
- 3. Supplementary Information Form for Language Students
- 4. If you are studying at another university/school in China, please submit a study transcript and an attendance letter issued by the International Student Office or the school of your host university with their contact information.

Step 3: Pay the application fee RMB 450: It can be paid through online payment, through bank wire transfer or through credit/banking card in our office. **Please DON'T transfer through ATM.** Please refer to Appendix ④ for Remittance Information.

Step 4: Submit the application form

【Admission and registration 】

- 1. We will issue an electronic version of the Admission Notice and electronic version of the Visa Application Form for Study in China to those who are accepted by Shanghai Jiao Tong University.
- 2. Visa: The relevant documents for applying for a student visa or Residence Permit for study will be notified by email. The visa application form for foreign students in China will be issued electronically.

Those who study for more than 180 days will receive a JW202 form, and those who study for less than 180 days will receive a DQ form. After receiving the email, students should visit the "Study in China" website (<u>https://www.studyinchina.edu.cn</u>), click "Visa Application", and download the files.

- 3. Students should bring their passport, Admission Notice, Visa Application form, and other required documents to the Embassy or Consulate of the People's Republic of China to apply for a student Visa (X1 or X2).
- 4. Students shall come to Shanghai Jiao Tong University on the registration date indicated on the Admission Notice.

- 5. Students will get the timetable (Please refer to Appendix ①), buy insurance, pay the tuition, and take the placement test during the registration day.
- 6. If the student is not admitted due to unsuccessful document review, the application fee will not be refunded.

[Insurance]

According to the pertinent regulations of the Ministry of Education and the school, the school will exercise full-member insurance system for international students. International students must have insurance in accordance with relevant national regulations and school requirements. (Visa)

Students must study on a student visa, the student visa doesn't have any working or internship permission. Those who have no valid student visa (X1/X2) or Residence Permit will be rejected to enroll or study at SJTU. For more details, please contact Tel: +86-21-62931076 and <u>clpvisa@sjtu.edu.cn</u>

[Accommodation Registration]

No on-campus accommodation for non-degree Chinese Language students

According to Article 39 of the Exit and Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China, foreigners who live or stay in a residence other than a hotel shall register with the public security organ of their place of residence and make a declaration within 24 hours after check-in. The procedure is as follows: Please go to the Student Service Center of Xuhui Campus to obtain the Temporary Accommodation Registration Form with your passport and rental contract; After that, take the FORM to the local police station to apply for the REGISTRATION FORM OF TEMPORARY RESIDENCE for overseas personnel. Overseas residents can also scan the QR code by mobile phone, select a language, and self-declare after registration.



[Refund Policy]

If you withdraw from the course in the middle of the semester, the registration fee will not be refunded. According to the Chinese Language Handbook for International Students, 75% of the tuition fee will be refunded in the first two weeks of the course, 50% of the tuition fee will be refunded in the third week, and from the fourth week onwards, the tuition fee for the semester will not be refunded.

[Certificate of Completion]

Students are required to attend class on time and take the final exam. Those who pass the examination will be issued a certificate of completion and a transcript.
